Bartender

Langwater Farm (est. 2010) is a family farm growing certified organic fruit and vegetables on nearly 80 acres in North Easton, MA. We produce over 60 different crops and distribute through our on-farm farm store, our 600 member CSA, 3 weekly summer and 1 weekly winter farmers' markets, and wholesale to restaurants, schools, and local aggregators/distributors. Langwater Farm's mission is to grow healthy, delicious, organic produce of the highest quality to feed our community. In 2022, we completed construction of our new year-round farm store and kitchen. In 2025, we obtained our full liquor license and created our Garden Bar under a new pavillion. We serve seasonal cocktails created around our own fruit and produce, craft beers from local breweries, and local wines.

Position Description

The bartender is a member of the farm's retail team. This part-time position reports to the Garden Bar Manager, Sarah Buchan. Our ideal candidate is a professional who works well in a fast-paced environment and has great customer service skills. Special consideration will be given for a food/beverage/restaurant background, and an aesthetic eye.

This is a part-time, seasonal position beginning in May 2026, and wrapping up in late October 2026.

Responsibilities

- Oversee Garden Bar operations and ensure seamless service and exceptional customer service.
- Daily set up and break down of the Garden Bar
- Build a rapport with regular customers to create a positive atmosphere
- Maintain high standards of beverage quality, presentation & cleanliness.
- Implement and enforce Health & Safety regulations and practices.
- Comfortably working in fast-paced and stressful environments.

- Mix traditional and creative cocktails
- Conducting nightly inventories
- Processing credit card & cash transactions
- Physical ability to stand or walk for long periods of time
- Ability to lift and carry heavy objects (5 gal kegs/logs + other bar supplies)
- Prepare garnishes & syrups when applicable
